## **Transfer Your IRA to That Man May See**

### **Legislation Signed Permanently Extending IRA Charitable Rollover**

On December 18, 2015, the president signed into law legislation that includes a permanent extension of the IRA charitable rollover.

The IRA charitable rollover allows taxpayers aged 70½ or older to make tax-free charitable gifts of up to \$100,000 per year directly from their individual retirement accounts to eligible charities, such as That Man May See. This is now a permanent part of the US tax code.

### **Benefits to You While Supporting Vision**

The transfer generates neither taxable income nor a tax deduction, so you will receive the benefit even if you do not itemize your tax deductions.

Your IRA contribution to That Man May See makes a huge difference for advancing research translated rapidly to patient care. You become a partner in the landmark campaign to build a center devoted to understanding eye and brain connections that can lead to breakthroughs solving the complex issues of blindness and vision loss.

### **Your Long-Range Strategy**

Another tax-wise strategy is to name That Man May See as beneficiary of all or a portion of your IRA assets. By naming That Man May See as beneficiary of your IRA, you can leave a gift that is free of all income and estate taxes because you are supporting a charitable organization.
